

# Bradbury Pool Rules 2022

1. Patrons are responsible for reading and obeying all posted rules.
2. No loud radios – loud is at discretion of the lifeguards.
3. No glass, pets, tobacco, or nicotine products (including electronic cigarettes.)
4. No running, pushing, shoving, dunking, or horseplay.
  - a. No flips, cannon balls, belly flops, diving or twisting jumps of the edge/side of pool.
5. No rafts, water-wings or inflatables allowed.
6. All swimmers must pass a proficiency/safety test by being able to swim the length of the pool to the satisfaction of the lifeguards.
7. All non-proficient swimmers may use a US Coastguard approved life jacket, puddle-jumper, and must be within arms always reach of a caregiver.
8. No hand balls, tennis balls, footballs, frisbees, aquatic guns, or tennis rackets.
9. During pool hours, the pool will be cleared every hour for a 15-minute lap swim.
10. Lifeguards have complete authority at the pool. If it offends or it is unsafe to pool patrons, the lifeguards will enforce rules leaning on the side of safety. Violation of pool rules may result in the offender's removal from the pool area, or in extreme cases, the police will be called and/or pool privileges may be suspended.
11. Residents shall be responsible for damage to the property of the Association caused by their family and guests.
12. Owners must be current in payment of association assessments before they will be permitted to register and use the pool.

## Wading Pool

1. The wading pool is for our small guests, if you are taller than 42" please enjoy the large pool as long as you meet swimming proficient standards, have an approved floatation device and/or caregiver, if necessary.
2. **No Lifeguard** is provided for the wading pool, all non-swimmers must be always accompanied by a caregiver.
3. Young children who are not toilet trained **are required** to wear swim diapers. Please remember to take your child to the restroom often. If a child has a "potty" accident in the pool, it may require a mandatory (per Health Department) closure of a minimum of 30 minutes up to 24 hours for cleaning.

## Guest Policy

1. Each household is permitted a maximum of 5 guests per day.
2. Special arrangements for parties of 10 or more must be made through the pool management company. Proper Lifeguard scheduling requires advance notice and residents will be responsible for any changes associated with the need for additional lifeguards.
