

Idyllwilde 2026 Pool Rules

Pool Open 10 AM – 8 PM daily during Pool Season

Please Be Courteous and Respectful to Ensure Everyone's Safety and Enjoyment.

*The Pool Rules apply to the Pool Area**

AUTHORITY & BEHAVIOR

1. **Lifeguard Authority:** Lifeguards have full authority to interpret and enforce all pool rules.
2. **Zero Tolerance:** There is zero tolerance for profanity, public intoxication, unsafe or inappropriate behavior, verbal or physical abuse toward lifeguards, staff, or residents.
3. **Compliance:** Attendees must follow all posted rules and promptly comply with lifeguard directives. Arguing with or obstructing a lifeguard is prohibited. If you disagree with a directive, comply first and then email the Community Manager afterward to explain your concern.
4. **Prohibited Substances:** Smoking, vaping, tobacco usage, and illegal drugs are prohibited on all Idyllwilde Association Common Areas, including the **Pool Area***.
5. **Enforcement:** Rule violations may result in the immediate removal of the entire party from the **HOA Grand Hall Common Area*** for the day. Suspensions are reported to the Community Manager and Board. Police may be called for additional enforcement.

ACCESS

1. **Entry:** Residents must sign-in and use their HOA access device to enter the Pool Area. Access is limited to Homeowners and their guests. **No tailgating***.
2. **Guest Policy:** A maximum of four (4) guests per household. Guests must always be accompanied by the Homeowner's immediate family.
3. **Capacity:** Lifeguards may restrict attendee access if the Pool Area reaches capacity.
4. **Supervision:** Children 12 years old and under must be accompanied by a parent or caregiver. Caregivers must be at least 16 and are fully responsible for the children in their care.

ATTIRE & HYGIENE

1. **Swimwear:** Only appropriate swimwear is permitted. Cut-off shorts are prohibited.
2. **Diapers:** All swimmers who are incontinent must wear swim diapers. No plastic, disposable or cloth diapers are permitted. Accidents may result in pool closure.
3. **Health:** Persons with open sores, skin infections, or bandages are not permitted in the water.
4. **Indoor Restrictions:** No wet swimsuits allowed in the Grand Hall Gym, Lobby and Great Room.

WEAK SWIMMERS

1. **Active Supervision:** Anyone unable to swim the full length of the pool independently, must remain within arm's reach of a proficient swimmer (minimum age: 16) while in the water.

2. **Flotation Devices:** Only U.S. Coast Guard–approved life jackets are permitted unless directly supervised within arm’s length of a proficient swimmer. See the reference chart in the lifeguard office. Lifeguards are authorized to remove any floatation device at any time.

SAFETY

1. **Lifeguard on Duty:** Swimming is only permitted when a lifeguard is on duty, unless otherwise posted. Safety breaks are called by the lifeguards at 12:00 PM, 2:00 PM, 4:00 PM, and 6:00 PM daily. All swimmers must exit the pool during this 10-minute safety break.
2. **Prohibited Conduct:** Diving, running, rough play, and throwing hard objects (e.g., hard balls/toys) are prohibited. Soft toys may be used at the lifeguard’s discretion.
3. **Floats:** Large floats are prohibited. Lifeguards may disallow any float at any time.
4. **Closures:** Pool may close without notice due to weather, maintenance, or safety concerns.
5. **Animals:** Animals are prohibited in the Pool Area, except as permitted by law.
6. **Wheels:** Bicycles, scooters, skateboards, and rollerblades are prohibited in the Pool Area.
7. **Slide Rules:** All posted slide rules must be followed. No floats allowed on slide.
8. **Mermaid Tails:** Not permitted.
9. **Noise:** Volume must remain at a level that does not disturb others. Only lifeguards are authorized to adjust the pavilions’ speaker volume.

FOOD & BEVERAGES

1. **Glass: NO GLASS** allowed in in the Pool Area or **Pavilion 3*** area.
2. **Prohibited Items:** No gum or seeds (sunflower, etc.) are permitted.
3. **Food/drinks:** Food/drinks are allowed in the Pool Area but prohibited inside the water.
4. **Clean Up:** Attendees must clean up after themselves and put trash in trash bins.
5. **Seating:** First Come/First Serve basis. Reserved seating is not permitted.

LEGAL, DEFINITIONS, MAP

1. **Rule Changes:** The Board reserves the right to change these rules at any time without notice.
2. **Liability for Damage:** Homeowners are financially responsible for any damage caused by family members, renters, or guests.

4. ***Definitions:**
 - **“Pool Area”:** the area inside the fence containing the pool.
 - **“Pavilion 3”:** the pavilion next to the Grand Hall, outside the pool fence.
 - **“HOA Grand Hall Common Area”** is the whole complex: Grand Hall, patios, upper deck, parking lot, emergency parking circle, tower, HOA open space.
 - **“Tailgating”** is the act of sneaking into an area behind an authorized person.
