Idyllwilde Master Association Facilities Rules & Regulations

Idyllwilde Pool Rules

General:

Use of the Idyllwilde pool is restricted to residents and their authorized guests. Pool rules apply to the pool area inside the fence. Users must be respectful of others.

Lifeguards have the authority to enforce rules. There is zero tolerance for ignoring lifeguard directions, inappropriate language, loud noise and unsafe or disruptive behavior.

Pool Use:

The resident's key fob is required for each entry. No shadowing is allowed.

No swimming without a lifeguard unless posted otherwise no diving, running, or rough play

Residents and guests are responsible for reading and obeying all posted signs.

Guests

Adult residents are allowed up to 4 guests maximum per household and must always be in attendance with the guests. At any time, the lifeguards can change the number of guests allowed.

Safety:

When in the water, weak/non-swimmers need to always be within arm's reach of an adult.

No large floats. Lifeguards have the discretion to prohibit any float.

Children:

Under 12 must be with a parent or caregiver over the age of 16.

Swim diapers are required for non-potty-trained children.

Restrictions:

No glass is allowed in the pool area.

No smoking, vaping or use of illegal substances anywhere on facility premises

No animals in pool area unless permitted by law.

Liability Waiver

Residents and their guests use the facility at their own risk. The HOA is not responsible for injuries or lost items. Residents are responsible for damages caused by their family and/or guests.

Enforcement & Violations

Violations of these rules may result in immediate suspension of pool privileges for the whole party and possible legal and/or financial actions.

Other:

Food and beverages are allowed in the chair and table sections of the pool area. Clean up all trash.

Pool may close due to weather or maintenance.

No wet swimsuits on furniture inside the Grand Hall 1st level.
