

# SADDLE ROCK NORTH POOL RULES

1. THE LIFEGUARD SHALL enforce all rules at all times and have full authority regarding pool use and safety, and must be obeyed at all times. THE LIFEGUARD SHALL NOT be considered a supervisor of your children, or your babysitter. The lifeguard stands are for lifeguards only. Lifeguard breaks will occur as needed during the last ten (10) minutes of each hour the pool is open. All persons shall exit the pool during this break period.
2. All children **under the age of 13** must be supervised by an Adult. An Adult is considered to be 18 years of age or older.
3. The BABY POOL is for the use of children 5 years of age and under. Parents or sitters must supervise their children in the baby pool at all times. Diapers, whether cloth or disposable, MUST be covered with rubber pants. The Board reserves the right to charge individuals for sanitizing the pool.
4. Do not obstruct the view of the lifeguards to the baby pool.
5. Flotation devices (rafts, inner-tubes, etc.) other than “noodles” are prohibited in the pool. An infant or child may wear a securely attached flotation device provided an adult is supervising the child at arms - length distance in the water at all times.
6. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages, cuts or recent vaccinations are not permitted in the pool.
7. ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS, Alcohol, chewing gum, smoking or chewing tobacco in the pool area at any time.
8. Horseplay, running, spitting, undue splashing, high power water guns and foul language or dangerous behavior at the pool will not be allowed.
9. No diving from the shallow end of the pool.
10. No bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, strollers without wheel locks, or other non-pool play equipment will be allowed in the swimming pool areas.
11. Trash shall be disposed of in appropriate containers.
12. Pets are not allowed in the pool area.
13. GUESTS must be accompanied by a Saddle Rock North resident.
14. State law requires the Gate to be locked at all times. The gate will automatically close, and state law forbids it being held open. No climbing on the fence in permitted
15. Members who repeatedly offend other members with behavior contrary to the preceding guidelines will have pool privileges suspended and or be fined by the HOA.
