

2026 POOL RULES

SADDLE ROCK METROPOLITAN DISTRICT

1. **The Saddle Rock Metropolitan District has a ZERO TOLERANCE POLICY for violations of any rules and regulations. Automatic revocation of pool privileges can occur with the first violation.**
2. THE LIFEGUARD SHALL enforce all rules at all times and have full authority regarding pool use and safety and must be obeyed at all times. THE LIFEGUARD SHALL NOT be considered a supervisor of your children, or babysitter. The lifeguard stands are for lifeguards only. Lifeguard breaks will occur as needed during the last ten (10) minutes of each hour the pool is open. All persons shall exit the pool during this break period.
3. All individuals under the age of 13 must be supervised by an Adult (an individual at least eighteen (18) years of age).
4. The WADER POOL is for the use of individuals 5 years of age and under and they must be supervised at all times while in the baby pool. Diapers, whether cloth or disposable, MUST be covered with rubber pants. **The Board reserves the right to charge responsible individuals for sanitizing the pool.**
5. Do not obstruct the view of the lifeguards to the baby pool.
6. Flotation devices (rafts, inner-tubes, etc.) other than "noodles" are prohibited in the pool. An individual may wear a securely attached flotation device provided an Adult is supervising the individual at arms-length distance in the water at all times.
7. Persons having infectious diseases, open sores, bandages or cuts are not permitted in the pool.
8. ABSOLUTELY NO GLASS, alcohol, chewing gum, smoking, vaping or chewing tobacco in the pool area at any time.
9. Horseplay, running, spitting, undue splashing, high power water guns and foul language or dangerous behavior at the pool will not be allowed.
10. **No diving.**
11. No bicycles, tricycles, skateboards, roller skates, roller blades, strollers without wheel locks, or other non-pool play equipment will be allowed in the swimming pool areas.
12. Trash shall be disposed of in appropriate containers.
13. Pets (except for service animals) are not allowed in the pool area.
 - Service animals are those animals trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability
 - Assistance animals are not allowed in the pool area. Special accommodations may be provided for assistance animals, pursuant to the Federal Housing Act

14. GUESTS must be accompanied by a Saddle Rock Metropolitan District resident or owner. No more than four (4) guests per day per resident household.
15. State law requires the gate to the pool be locked at all times. The gate will automatically close, and state law forbids it being held open. No climbing on the fence is permitted.
16. Individuals who repeatedly offend other individuals with behavior contrary to the preceding guidelines will have pool privileges suspended and or be fined by the Saddle Rock Metropolitan District. Such revocation may occur at the first violation.
17. Lifeguards will close the pools if lighting is spotted.
18. NO LIFEGUARD HOURS - Lifeguards are NOT on duty during NO LIFEGUARD HOURS—SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK. NO LIFEGUARD HOURS available only to owners and residents, no guests allowed. See pool times for no lifeguard time period.
19. In the basketball area basketballs may only be thrown or shot from inside the water no more than ten (10) feet from the net (not from the deck or wall). Dunking and/or hanging from the rim is not permitted.
20. Slides are not to be used during Non-Lifeguard Swim Times.
